FOUNDATION TIER

The starting point

The baseline every engagement begins with. It establishes the security footing your congregation needs before training or program development can be effective. Higher tiers include Foundation work if it is not already complete.

Safety and Security Assessment

A comprehensive evaluation of your facility, policies, and team capabilities. We identify vulnerabilities, review existing protocols, and deliver a prioritized action plan your leadership can act on immediately.

Emergency Operations and Protection Plan (EOPP)

A custom, congregation-specific plan covering threat scenarios, communication protocols, roles and responsibilities, and response procedures. Built for your people, your space, and your mission.

DEVELOPMENT TIER

Builds on Foundation

Builds directly on the Foundation Tier. A completed Assessment and EOPP must be in place; where they are not, that work is scoped into your Development engagement.

Safety Team Training and Development

Structured training in situational awareness, de-escalation, threat recognition, and response coordination. Grounded in proven law enforcement and military tradecraft and force protection measures, adapted for the church environment.

Rules of Engagement Documentation

Clear, legally informed guidance defining how your team responds to threats at every level. Reduces hesitation, protects your congregation, and gives volunteers the confidence to act decisively.

Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management (BTAM) Integration

Training and protocols that help your team identify concerning behavior before it escalates, building a culture of calm, informed observation rather than reactive response.

ENTERPRISE TIER

Comprehensive program

For congregations with a mature program already in place, or those ready to build comprehensively under a single engagement. Any missing Foundation or Development work is scoped in.

Ongoing Safety Program Management

A sustained, maturing program with quarterly reviews, scenario-based exercises, policy updates, and continuous improvement support from a dedicated consultant.

Multi-Site Coordination

Security strategy and training coordinated across multiple campuses or affiliated congregations, ensuring consistency, communication, and unified response capability.

ADD-ON SERVICES

Available to congregations at any tier, either as supplements to an existing engagement or as standalone services where noted.

Safety and Security Assessment (Standalone)

A professional vulnerability assessment and action plan before committing to a full tier. An ideal first step for leadership teams exploring their options.

Active Threat Response Workshop

A scenario-based workshop for the full congregation or leadership team, covering Run, Hide, Fight principles, communication under stress, and post-incident care.

Pistol Qualification Course (Armed Team Members)

A structured qualification for armed Safety Team members covering marksmanship standards, safe handling, legal considerations, and shoot and no-shoot judgment.

Leadership Consultation (Single Session)

A focused session for senior pastors, elders, or executive staff to assess readiness, ask hard questions, and get honest, experienced guidance.

On-Call Advisory Retainer

Year-round access for questions, incident consultation, policy review, and leadership guidance. Billed monthly, with no full program commitment required.

Intelligence and Information Capability Development NEW

Training and protocols to gather, evaluate, and act on threat-relevant information from your community, law enforcement, and open sources, before risks reach your doors.

Pistol Qualification Development Course

A curriculum course for Safety Team leaders building or formalizing a qualification program. Covers course of fire design, standards, legal considerations, and documentation.

Medical Support Team Development

A framework for first-responder medical capability, including volunteer role definition, equipment and radio protocols, response procedures, and coordination with your Safety Team.

Annual EOPP Review and Update

An annual review of your existing plan to reflect current threats, personnel changes, facility updates, and lessons learned from exercises or incidents.
